Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 1.2.2015. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The true copy of Identity Card issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Communication and I.T., Department of Posts, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and the true copy of Passport, Republic of India, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 2, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2. The marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 11.2.2015 (Annexure-P-5) before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 11.2.2015 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
