Mr. Kuldeep Khandelwal, Advocate, has filed power of attorney on behalf of respondents no.4 and 5 which is taken on record.

Instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 and 5. The petitioners assert that they are major and as there is no legal impediment, they have got married. They have already moved application dated 14.02.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, for protecting

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their life and liberty.

Vide order dated 20.02.2015 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, notice of motion was issued and interim direction was issued that none of the petitioners would be taken in custody by any of the respondents, forcibly on the allegation that petitioner No.1 has been abducted or raped by petitioner No.2.

Learned counsel for respondents no.4 and 5 states that respondents no.4 and 5 have no objection to the marriage performed by the petitioners.

In view of above, order dated 20.02.2015 is made absolute.
