Instant petition has been moved under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a complaint No.72 dated March 11, 2013 under Sections 302, 382, 201, 511 and 34 IPC captioned as **Surain Singh vs. Paramjit Kaur etc.**

Notice issued to respondent has been received back unserved with the report that he has been taken away by nature.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners has furnished the copy of order dated March 09, 2015, which discloses that both the petitioners have already appeared before learned trial Court in compliance of order dated February 25, 2015 and have furnished the requisite bail bonds.

Since, it is a complaint case, custodial interrogation of petitioners is not required. However, chances of disposal of complaint in the near future are also remote.

In the given circumstances, it could not be desirable to keep instant petition pending for further period.

Accordingly, instant petition stands disposed of while making the order dated February 25, 2015 absolute.
