The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.395 dated 3.9.2013 under Sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act registered at Police Station, Tripuri Town, Patiala.

Alleged recovery from the petitioner is of 1000 tablets containing Diphenoxylate hydrochloride, as per report of the Chemical Examiner.

In the light of such alleged heavy recovery, this Court is not inclined to grant benefit of regular bail.

Present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 3.9.2013 and the challan was presented on 30.1.2014, it is directed that the Trial Court would make every endeavor to expedite the trial.

Disposed of.
