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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.1 dated 20.01.2015, registered under Sections 13(1)(d) read with Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 27.03.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and have cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Jagdish Singh, DSP Vigilance has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.03.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
