Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 10.03.2014, under Section 302. 450. 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

As per allegation of the prosecution, Deepak hit Vinod on his head with a bat and Ashish gave bottle blow on his head, Rohtash fired two shots from his pistol on the forehead and Devender fired one shot from his pistol on the chest and the second shot on the right cheek of Vinod. Vinod fell down and all those four persons ran away from the spot.

The FIR was registered against these four persons and later on, on 21.08.2014, the name of the petitioner cropped-up as conspirator on the basis of supplementary statement of the brother of complainant, namely, Suresh. The petitioner is a lady and is in custody since 02.09.2014. The name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition stands allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
