MAHESH GROVER, J.

The pre-arrest bail of the petitioner stands dismissed by virtue of order dated 18.3.2015. Evidently, the petitioner did not comply with the terms of the aforesaid order. In case he does so and after depositing the amount furnishes the receipt and thereafter makes a prayer for regular bail, the same shall be considered by the court of competent jurisdiction and disposed of in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible but not later than three days from the date of making such prayer.
