REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been preferred by the petitioner for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the behest of her parents and other family members on the premise that they want to perform her marriage forcibly with respondent No. 7. At present, she is residing with a friend namely Gaurav Deep son of Raj Pal at Zirakpur (Punjab), She has submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali for protection but to no result.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali to look into grievance of the petitioner expressed in the representation (Annexure P3) and take appropriate steps if any warranted in the circumstances, in accordance with law. However, nothing stated in this order shall restrain the police from taking action against the petitioner if she has committed any cognizable offence.
