**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.**

This is a second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.79 dated 03.05.2014 under Sections 376,306,420,34,384,120B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1. Jalandhar.

The allegations in this second regular bail application are that deceased Pardeep Kaur daughter of the brother of the petitioner committed suicide on 3.5.2014 by hanging herself and the present case has been lodged by the husband of the deceased namely Harwinder Singh and that Gurmej Singh non-applicant/co-accused, husband of the present petitioner had forced the deceased to enter into an illicit relation with him in the year 2001 and that the present-petitioner has facilitated the commission of crime and subsequently the couple

used to blackmail the deceased on the basis of her movie clip showing her to be in intimate condition. The contentions of the learned Senior counsel for the petitioner that no specific role is attributed to the petitioner who is in custody since 4.5.2014 and that nothing incriminating has been recovered from her to connect her with the crime and that the entire story is based on oral implausibility could not be controverted on behalf of the State.

In view thereof and keeping in view the vagueness of the allegations, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
