The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.349 dated 31.12.2014, registered under Sections 170, 419, 463, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Patti, Distt. Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of false implication. He is an old man aged about 80 years. The allegations levelled against the petitioner are not supported by any documentary evidence.

The learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the

petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 01.05.2015.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.05.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
