NAVITA SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 40 dated 25.05.2014 under Section 406/498-A/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, Punjab, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Respondent No. 2 has appeared through counsel, who has also filed her affidavit regarding the compromise.

Counsel for the petitioners pointed out that respondent No. 2, after the compromise, is living with her husband Yadwinder Singh i.e. petitioner No. 1. This fact was however not mentioned in the affidavit. Respondent No. 2 is present in Court who states that she is living with her husband.

Counsel for the parties have stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised. The matter involved is personal in nature.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the abovesaid FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.
