In this case, the allegations are of rape.

As per the stand of the State, on instructions from ASI Onkar Singh, the prosecutrix and her father have been examined and they have supported the prosecution case.

As per the custody certificate filed in Court today, the petitioner is in custody for the last 1 year, 5 months and 11 days.

Keeping in view the matter, the present petition for grant of regular bail is dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial, keeping in view the fact that it is offence against woman and the case be decided on priority.
