This petition has been moved by Rajesh Kumar under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.129 dated 5.9.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that trial has started but prosecution has not yet examined any of the witnesses. The petitioner is in custody since 26.10.2014.

Since the trial has not practically begun, it will take a long time to complete.

Keeping in view the offences for which the petitioner has been charge-sheeted and the fact that he is already in custody since October, 2014, the petition is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
