Report dated 29.4.2015 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur has been received after recording statements of accused Amrit Lal as well as complainant Inderjit Lal and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and to bring about personal harmony and more-so the offences for which the accused have been booked are not of very serious nature and both the parties belong to same village and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012**

(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 37 dated 2.3.2010 registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur under sections 436 IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
