**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the cross version in FIR No.160 dated 16.9.2014 under Sections 326/325/324/323/34 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 27.2.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to compliance of terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to

order dated 27.2.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 27.2.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when directed by the investigating officer and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
