This petition has been filed under Section 407 of Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for transfer of trial of the cases i.e. first, arising out of FIR No.80 dated 09.10.2013, registered under Sections 406/498-A of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar; second, petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. pending in the Court of Sh. Suresh Kumar Goyal, JMIC, Jalandhar and third, application under Sections 12 to 22 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, pending in the Court of Sh. Amrish Kumar, JMIC, Jalandhar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana or any

other District.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied, at this stage, in case, the trial Court is directed to hear all the cases at Jalandhar after clubbing them, if permissible by law, by the same bench and on the same day.

The learned counsel for the respondents does not have any objection to the proposal made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the consensus reached between the parties, it is ordered that the aforesaid cases be clubbed and heard together, by the same bench and on the same day. Accordingly, the parties are directed to appear before the District Judge, Jalandhar on 12.11.2015, who shall earmark the matter to the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Disposed of with the above observations.
