The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the order dated 22.08.2013 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga in terms of which, the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person in proceeding emanating from a private complaint titled as 'Shashi Bana Vs. Rajesh Kumar and others', under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

Counsel also asserts that the parties have since compromised and a compromise deed dated 12.01.2015 (Annexure P-4) has been drawn out.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition and furnishes an undertaking that the petitioner would surrender before the Trial Court within a period of four weeks from today.

Prayer is allowed.

The instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly

surrenders within the stipulated time frame of four weeks and files an application seeking bail, the same would be decided expeditiously and also keeping in mind any compromise that may have been entered between the parties.

Petition disposed of.
