The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439(2) for cancellation of bail of respondent No.2 passed by this Court vide order dated 20.01.2015 in CRM No.M-724 of 2014 in case FIR No.129 dated 14.06.2014, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala.

Even on repeated calls, none has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2.

The aforesaid order was passed on the basis of compromise alleged to be arrived at between Jarnail Singh and

Lakhwinder Kaur. The petitioner is an aggrieved person. Respondent No.2 i.e. Angrej Singh has obtained the said order by playing fraud with the Court that compromise has been effected with the complainant. The complainant has emphatically denied the factum of compromise.

So, in these circumstances, the order dated 20.1.2015, passed in CRM No.M-724 of 2014 in case FIR No.129 dated 14.06.2014, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala, stands re-called and the application seeking bail stands dismissed.

Respondent No.2 be taken into custody.
