This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 399/402 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur, vide FIR No.115 dated 3.9.2012.

Learned State counsel (on instructions from ASI Manohar Singh, who is present in Court) at the outset submits that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the case is at the stage of defence evidence.

As the trial is nearing its culmination, no ground to enlarge the petitioner on bail at this stage is made out.

Dismissed. However, in case the trial of the case is not concluded within a period of three months, the petitioner will be entitled to file a fresh petition with the same prayer.
