Main case

The petitioner has prayed for bail in a case FIR no.288 dated 5.9.2012 registered under Sections 302/120-B IPC at Police Station Tripri, Town, Patiala.

Sh.Hundal, learned State counsel in instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh states that the prosecution evidence has been recorded and the matter is fixed for defence evidence out of which a few witnesses have been examined which fact is also supported by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

If that be so then the trial is virtually at the fag end and the prayer of the petitioner has literally become illusory.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is suffering from schizophrenia and requires medical attention.

If that be so then this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents- State of Punjab and the jail authorities to take adequate steps by providing medical care to the petitioner while in jail during this period. Trial Court is also directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible. After the defence evidence is concluded it shall proceed to pronounce the order within a reasonable time considering the health condition of the petitioner.
