Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.263 dated 20.12.2013, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 ('Act' for short), registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana.

Petitioner was found in possession of 250 grams of heroin.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that quantity beyond 250 grams of heroin would constitute commercial quantity, whereas petitioner was found in possession of 250 grams of heroin. Petitioner is in custody since 20.12.2013.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant

Sub Inspector Paramjit Singh has submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case under the Act.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.
