Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.905 dated 24.12.2014 for offence under Section 395 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani.

Vide order dated 23.2.2015, the petitioner was granted interim protection with a direction to join investigation.
