The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.113 dated 23.07.2014 registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has urged that 3 persons were arrested and recovery of 2510 Mls. of intoxicating solution was effected and the petitioner is in custody since 23.07.2014 and despite the lapse of more than 7½ months, the forensic report has not come and prays that at least till that time the petitioner be released on interim bail. He further states that both the co-accused have been granted interim bail by the Co-ordinate Bench.

In my opinion, in the absence of the FSL report it would not be fair to keep the petitioner in custody indefinitely. Resultantly, the petition is partly allowed. The petitioner is allowed interim bail to the satisfaction of the Court concerned till the report of FSL is received. The State would inform the accused about the submission of the report and the accused would surrender before the Court concerned.
