Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.91 dated 01.08.2012 under Sections 15, 25, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

Notice of motion was issued.

Neither anybody has come present nor any request for pass over has been made.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhraj Singh, Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka, submits that since out of 10 prosecution witnesses, 08 have already been examined and only 02 are left to be examined, trial is likely to be concluded shortly. Next date of hearing before the learned trial Court is 19.05.2015. He further submits that petitioner is not entitled for bail pending trial.

Having considered the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and after hearing learned counsel for the State, no case for bail pending trial is made out.
