Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 15.2.2015. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure- P-4. The true copy of Passport, Republic of India, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and true copy of Identity Card issued by the Election Commission of India, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 2 have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2. The marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an representation dated 16.02.2015 (Annexure-P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Saheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Saheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab to consider the representation of the petitioners dated 16.02.2015 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
