SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.6 dated 27.1.2015 under Sections 409/420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Noormahal, Jalandhar.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that Palwinder Singh was working as a Clerk in the Government Senior Secondary School, Kot Badal Khan and he had withdrawn huge amount from the Treasury Office by preparing fake pay bills under some fake names including the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was innocent and has been falsely involved in this case. In fact, petitioner was a shop keeper and had no concern with the school in question.

In the present case, the allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. In fact, as per the prosecution story, Palwinder Singh had withdrawn money by preparing fake bills under

fake names including the petitioner. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation. Hence, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
