Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No. 65, dated 12.06.2008, under Sections 353, 224, 225, 186, 506 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dasuya, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that charge has

been framed and the petitioner has been behind bars since 26.06.2014. The learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his/their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.
