Petitioner, through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks a direction to the respondents to take appropriate action on the cross-case under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC which was got registered at the instance of petitioner in FIR No. 92 dated May 3, 2014 against the petitioner's party on the statement of Mukhtiar Singh alleging that the petitioner, her son and relatives had entered in the house of complainant and caused injuries to him.

Petitioner seems to have not approached any of the senior police officers for intervention by expressing the grievance raised in the present petition.

The petition is disposed of as premature with liberty to the petitioner to approach the senior police officers with a prayer for necessary action.
