The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.558 dated 21.08.2014 under Sections 406/420/467/468/471/506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Jhajjar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR was registered on the complaint of one Rajesh Kumar and the allegations primarily are with regard to the present petitioner along with his brother-Suresh Chander having sold the manure pit for a sale consideration of Rs.30,000/- and having handed over the possession of the same even though the same very manure pit had allegedly been sold by the petitioner as also his brother earlier in point of time to one Dalip Singh, accused No.3, who thereafter had taken over the possession of such manure pit from the complainant.

The petitioner has been in custody since 09.12.2014.

Perusal of the order dated 31.12.2014 passed by the Additional

Sessions Judge, Jhajjar declining the relief of regular bail to the petitioner would reveal that it had been noticed that co-accused Suresh Chander i.e. brother of the petitioner was absconding.

During the course of hearing, it stands conceded that Suresh Chander has approached this Court by filing CRM No.M-5555 of 2015 and has been granted ad interim protection as regards arrest.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ranvir Singh would apprise the Court that Suresh Chander i.e. brother of the present petitioner has since joined investigation. Learned State counsel further submits that investigation is at the final stage and the challan would be filed shortly.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of CJM, Jhajjar.

Disposed of.
