The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.164 dated 06.10.2014 registered under Sections 406, 498-A and 323 IPC at Police Station City Batala Police, District Batala.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and husband of the complainant.

Vide order dated 27.02.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioners while referring the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The settlement has not been arrived at between the parties. It is not in dispute that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Considering the aforesaid facts and noticing that the dispute is of marital nature and the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, the instant petition is allowed. The interim orders dated 27.02.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to condition that the petitioners would continue to comply with the

provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed of.
