Learned counsel for respondent submits that petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. titled as Mrs. Anju Verma and another vs. Gautam Verma (Petition No.26 dated 29.11.2012), the transfer of which has been sought by the petitioner, has since been decided by the court. Learned counsel for respondent further submits that the transfer of petition under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (43 of 2005) has been sought on the ground that the respondent is posted as Civil Nazir in the District Courts at Mohali. He has since been transferred from Mohali to Ropar, as such very basis of the plea raised by the petitioner has fizzled out. He further submits that the other litigation including the criminal cases in between the parties are also pending at District Courts, Mohali and the petitioner has not sought transfer of those petitions.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent and due to non appearance of the petitioner or her counsel on the last two consecutive dates of hearing, this petition is dismissed.
