Counsel for the petitioner submits that the bail application of the co-accused of the petitioner Salwant Singh @ Bhola has been decided by this Court on February 18, 2015 directing that the trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to conclude the trial on April 30, 2015 by giving short dates of hearing. It has been observed in the said order that in case the trial is not concluded by April 30, 2015, he would be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court after expiry of said period.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition for bail be also disposed of in the same terms.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case. The above said order has been passed taking into consideration the age and ailment of the co-accused of the petitioner. It goes without saying that the petitioner as co-accused of Salwant Singh will also be entitled to get the benefit of expeditious disposal of the trial. SI Sarwan Singh present in the Court, informs that one PW remains to be examined.

In view of the status of the trial, this petition is disposed of by following the order passed qua other petitioner that attempt will be made by the trial Court to conclude the trial by April 30, 2015.

Disposed of in the above terms. However, it is observed that in case the trial is not concluded by said date, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
