The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.49, dated 29.10.2013, registered under Sections 363, 506, 376(d) of the IPC, Sections 66, 67 of the Information Technology Act, and Section 5 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012, at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

Interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner on the ground that all the other co-accused were acquitted and the petitioner was absconding and, therefore, could not be proceeded against. Thereafter the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on

interim bail. In these circumstances, this petition is allowed and the interim order dated 25.2.2015 is made absolute. Let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer on 27.8.2015 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, for investigation.
