The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for seeking regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.15, dated 09.01.2015 under Section 381/34 IPC, registered at Police Station-A Division, Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

The present case has been registered on the statement of one Ravi Taneja and allegation was that Rs.2,52,730/- were stolen from an almirah lying inside the office. It has also been alleged that footage of CCTV camera has been examined and as per which workers namely Sumit Kumar, Vishal and Anil were found near the office of the factory and as such the finger of suspicion was pointed towards them.

It has gone uncontroverted that the name of the present petitioner did not figure in the FIR. He has been subsequently implicated on the basis

of disclosure statement of the co-accused. The petitioner has been in custody since 14.01.2015. The offence under Section 381 IPC is triable by the Court of Magistrate. It may also be noticed that Sumit Kumar @ Sumit Sharma whose name figured in the FIR has been granted the benefit of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 25.02.2015 in CRM-M-No.5585 of 2015.

Prayer in the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner is held entitled to the concession of bail. Bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
