This petition has been filed by the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.177 dated 24.12.2014 under Section 379 IPC and Section 21-A of the Mines and Minerals Act, Police Station Valtoha, Distt. Tarn Taran.

The allegations are that the petitioners were escaped from the spot by leaving the trollas loaded with sand.

Learned State counsel on the instruction of HC Gurdial Singh, Police Station Valtoha has stated that both the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They have been sufficiently interrogated. No recovery is to be effected from them and they are not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of the aforesaid as the detention of the petitioners is not required for any purpose, so the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 25.02.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
