The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.101 dated 07.11.2014, registered under Section 458, 294, 109, 323, 325, 506, 148, 149, 459 IPC, Police Station Bakshiwala, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel states that on preliminary inquiry Sections 458, 459, 148 and 149 IPC have been deleted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the offences which now remain are Section 323, 325, 506 and Section 294 IPC. It is stated that investigation is almost over and the petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2015.

Considering the above circumstances and since the trial

will take long time to conclude, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate.
