Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect her life and liberty as well as the life and liberty of her family members from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 09.02.2015 (Annexure P-2), given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, by the petitioner, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

The allegation in the present petition is that respondent Nos.5 to 10 are putting pressure upon the petitioner for compromise in case FIR No.26 dated 28.01.2015, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, under Section 376 IPC.

In view of above, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala is directed to look into the said representation as per law and get the matter inquired immediately within 1 month from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Respondent No.2 is also directed to take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members if he/she satisfies that respondent Nos.5 to 10 are actually putting pressure upon the petitioner.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
