This petition has been filed for quashing FIR No.413 dated 17.8.2013, registered under Sections 363, 366A, 376D, 406, 342, 506, 120-B, 354D(2) IPC and under Section 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

In a connection petition bearing CRM 33342 of 2014 came up for hearing before this Court and disposed of today, reply has been filed by the State in which it has been stated that after investigation the cancellation report has been presented before the Court. It is further stated that Asma Khatoon @ Akshma has filed an affidavit to the effect that she had married to Aslam Khan on 27.1.2014 of her sweet will and now she is 7-8 months pregnant, as

on the date of furnishing of the affidavit. However, learned counsel for the petitioners therein has informed this Court that now she has been blessed with a child.

It being so, the present petition for quashing FIR No.413 dated 17.8.2013, registered under Sections 363, 366A, 376D, 406, 342, 506, 120-B, 354D(2) IPC and under Section 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat is disposed of as infructuous for the time being. However, the trial Court shall take into consideration the affidavit filed by Asma Khatoon @ Akshma and the present status of the case while deciding on the cancellation report. However, if the petitioners are still aggrieved they can again approach this Court in case of an adverse order is passed by the trial Court.
