Report dated 05.12.2015 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Ashraf Masih and Usha as well as of complainant Rajinder Pal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure property dispute and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.59 dated 20.04.2014 under Sections 406,420 IPC, Police Station, Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby

quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
