This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 71 dated 10.09.2013, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

The learned counsel refers to the enquiry report (Annexure P-3) and states that a cancellation report was prepared in the present case.

There are specific allegations that the petitioner along with other co-accused entered the house of the complainant and caused injuries to him. Even, the injuries have been specifically

noticed in the MLR. In the circumstances, no case for quashing is made out.

Dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the incident pertains to the year 2013; the petitioner is a Canadian citizen and is constrained to come back due to the pendency of the present FIR, the investigating agency is directed to conclude the investigation expeditiously.
