RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 7.

The petitioner was married to Balbir Singh on 26.10.2013. Out of this wedlock, a female child was born on 24.08.2014. Thereafter, due to misunderstandings, she left her in-laws house on 18.02.2015. Even, she is not being supported by her own mother and is facing harassment.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to treat this petition as a representation, call the petitioner and respondent Nos. 4 to 7 and make an attempt to rehabilitate the petitioner along with minor daughter in her in-laws family.
