Petitioners seek quashing of complaint No.215 dated 14.06.2010, under Sections 498-A/406/506 IPC pending in the Court of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and summoning order dated 07.04.2011 on the basis of compromise.

The said complaint was registered at the instance of respondent-complainant Amarjot Kaur alleging that the petitioners had maltreated and tortured the complainant on account of bringing insufficient dowry.

Parties were directed to appear before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Matrimonial dispute having been amicably resolved and following the judgments of ***B.S. Joshi and others Vs. State of Haryana and another 2003 (2) RCR (Criminal) 888*** and ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052,*** the petition is allowed. The aforesaid criminal complaint and the summoning order against the petitioners are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
