This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.90 dated 27.07.2014 under Sections 148/149/323/324/452/307 and 506 IPC at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad.

Learned State counsel submits that efforts shall be made by the prosecution to lead its evidence without delay.

There is, thus, no ground to enlarge the petitioner on bail at this stage. However, he shall be at liberty to file afresh in case prosecution evidence does not conclude within a period of four months.
