Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.172 dated 30.09.2014 under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station E Division, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
