SABINA, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing the respondents to hand over the investigation in FIR No. 123 dated 29.7.2013 under Sections 406/420/120B/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Saha, District Ambala to some other independent agency.

Earlier petitioners had filed Criminal Misc. No.M-23295 of 2014 seeking same relief and the same was disposed of vide order dated 15.7.2014. The said order reads as under:-

“After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the Court of Magistrate as per the judgment of

Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Sakiri Vasu v.State of U.P. and others, 2008(1)R.C.R.(Cr.)392.**

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.”

In these circumstances, no ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
