Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.162 dated 26.12.2014, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana, under Sections 323, 325, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

The petitioner is husband of Manjit Kaur, complainant. As per FIR, complainant Manjit Kaur was married with petitioner on 22.04.2013. In the FIR, the allegation against the petitioner is that the demand of dowry has been raised and he gave beating to the complainant with fist blows etc. at night at about 11:00 p.m. on 02.12.2014 and she has been admitted in hospital and medico legally examined. The petitioner is named in the FIR. The FIR has been registered under Sections 323, 325, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC..

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the allegations against the petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where he is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
