The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') seeking quashing of the FIR No.35 dated 12.3.2010 (Annexure P-1), registered for offence punishable under Sections 406/498-A IPC at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-2).

As per case of the prosecution, the petitioners demanded dowry from the respondent No.2-complainant and also subjected her to cruelty and mental harassment.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the matter has been settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court where permanent alimony has been paid to respondent No.2. He further submits that the respondent No.2 has no objection if the impugned FIR along with all consequential proceedings is quashed.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.2 and keeping in view the fact that the matter has been finally settled between the parties as per report of Director, Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the instant petition is allowed and the impugned FIR (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom is quashed.
