The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.157 dated 30.12.2014 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 370, 511, 506 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 19, Panchkula.

The petitioner is mother-in-law of the complainant and prayed for anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. alleging that the marital discord between her son and the complainant would not mean that the petitioner is instrumental in meting out any maltreatment to the complainant.

This Court vide order dated 26.02.2015 had granted the interim bail to the petitioner pursuant to which she has joined the investigation, which fact has not been controverted by the State counsel on instructions from ASI Ramesh Chand. Rs.15,000/- has also been paid by the petitioner to the complainant.

Considering the aforesaid facts and noticing that the petitioner has since joined the investigation, the instant petition is allowed. The interim orders dated 26.02.2015 are hereby made

absolute subject to condition that the petitioner would continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
