SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.14 dated 1.2.2015 under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code,1860 registered at Police Station Majitha, Amritsar Rural, Tehsil and District Amritsar.

Prosecution story,in brief, is that Ranjeet Kaur, elder sister of the complainant-Kulwinder Singh was married to Ravinder Singh about 15 years prior to the registration of the FIR. However, Ravinder Singh and his father (petitioner) started harassing Ranjeet Kaur and used to give beatings to her. Ranjeet Kaur was thrown out of the matrimonial home on many occasions and last of all, she was thrown out of matrimonial home on 31.1.2015. Ranjeet Kaur consumed some poisonous substance on 31.1.2015, being fed up from the behaviour of the petitioner and her husband.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely involved in this case.

In the present case, the allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. Ranjeet Kaur, daughter-in-law of the petitioner committed suicide after she was thrown out of the matrimonial home by the petitioner and Ravinder Singh. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation. Hence, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
