The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.145 dated 23.10.2014 registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 341 and 34 IPC at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

It was contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he is not named in the FIR and has been roped in only on account of the alleged extra-judicial confession made by the accused. It was further contended that a person named Kala, who was named in the FIR, was granted the benefit of interim protection by this Court.

Noticing the aforesaid contentions this Court on March 04, 2015, had granted the interim protection to the petitioner subject to the compliance of the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner has since joined the

investigation as has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner and not controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab. Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated March 04.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
